### Holiday Reminders

With the holidays quickly approaching. it is important to remember that you are required to notify the guard at least 24 hours in advance of any event you are having in which you are expecting more that 12 guest vehicles. A list of the guests should be provided to the guard in alphabetical order and if possible, the license plate numbers of the vehicles. Events in which you are expecting more that 25 guest vehicles, you must notify the guard and management company at least 72 hours in advance. The same list of information must be provided to the guard house. However, the manager must be notified so that another guard can be hired to help manage the additional vehicle The cost for the additional access. guard will be paid by the homeowner. Your cooperation in this effort will not only help expedite access for your neighbors but for your guests as well.

# **Exterior Changes**

Before you perform any exterior changes to your home, you must first submit an architectural variance request application to the Board for review and approval. Changes made without association approval may not be permitted and will have to be changed.



#### Street Sweeper

The association streets are swept each Thursday. Please make sure your vehicles are not parked on the streets in order to allow the contractor to clean all portions of the streets and gutters.

# . Resident Parking

As a reminder, all residents are required to park their vehicles inside their garage or in their driveway. Residents are not permitted to park on the street without association approval and only for certain reasons. Please do not take a chance in this area as your vehicle may be cited and could be towed away at your expense.

# Fall Maintenance Reminders

With Fall quickly approaching, it is time to consider some basic maintenance items that can help protect your family and save you money. Some of the items to consider are:

- 1. Change the batteries in your smoke detectors.
- 2. Cut back the time and frequency of your irrigation water.
- 3. Replace the filters for your heating system.
