## Board Meeting Agendas

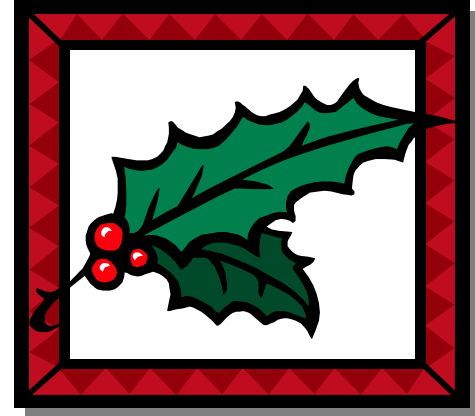
